Dear Y11 students,

Given national concern about the examination grades which A level students received last week, and the possibility of a similar situation with the GCSE results which are published on Thursday 21st August, the school has decided to pre-empt enquiries about sixth form entrance requirements by announcing that we will be accepting centre assessed grades (teacher assessed grades) for sixth form entrance, if necessary.

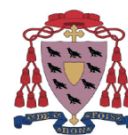
In summary, if your centre assessed grade will enable you to access a course and your examination grade will not, then we will accept the centre assessed grade.

If you are currently a pupil at our school we already have this information. If you are an external applicant we will request this information from your current school.

It is important that all applicants understand that this is an exceptional circumstance. Advanced level study is challenging and all students will, of course, have to ensure that they meet the on-going standards required to continue on the relevant course.
