Dear Parents / Carers,

Re: Uniform

As you will be aware, uniform is one of our six learning habits of excellence at St Aidan's. We believe that wearing a uniform develops a sense of pride in pupils, whilst also building a sense of identity within the St Aidan's community. The dress code applies both within school and on the journey to and from school.

I would like to take this opportunity to update you on an addition to our uniform policy. In the spring term, our Governors agreed that pupils should wear **only black or dark grey socks**. This change will come into place when return in September 2021.

Recently I have also been saddened to see a slight increase in the number of pupils who are attending school with haircuts that do not comply with what is set out in our uniform policy. May I remind you that our policy states:

Haircuts including stepped, undercut, tramlines, extremely close-cut styles (Number 2 or above is expected) or any pattern shaved into the hair or hair dye are not permitted. Longhair should be tied back from the face. No lines in eyebrows.
