Dear Parent/Carer,

It is recommended that all school pupils should have one personal guidance interaction before the end of Year 11. Therefore, your son will attend a scheduled Careers Guidance meeting with myself, to receive independent and impartial Career Guidance in preparation for his 'next steps'. All meetings will be documented onto a personalised action plan and additional support will be available via appointment with me, and scheduled drop in sessions.

Guidance meetings will commence 20.09.21, follow up sessions and additional support will be offered until the end of Year 11. Pupils will be issued with an appointment card to notify them of their meeting time and date and additional reminders will be given during morning meetings. Your son will begin to prepare for his guidance meeting during his PDE lessons and will complete a pre-guidance questionnaire to initiate initial discussions around his next steps.

In addition to this we will be holding a careers fair in school on the 20.10.21, your son will attend on the afternoon and parents/carers will be invited to meet with a range of education providers and employers after school. Further information will be shared in due course.

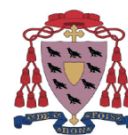
